1. Give an account of St. Paul's first journey in Asia Minor.
2. What is known of Theudas, Æneas, Apollos, Damaris, Mnason, Tabitha, Eutychus?
3. What persons are mentioned in the Acts bearing the name of Ananias, and what is known of them severally?
4. Explain,—
 - (a) "The high priest and all they that were with him, which is the sect of the Sadducees."
 - (b) "I am a Pharisee, the son of a Pharisee: of the hope and resurrection of the dead I am called in question."
 - (c) "Take heed what thou doest, for this man is a Roman."
 - (d) "Them take and purify thyself with them, and be at charges with them, that they may shave their heads."
5. Narrate the circumstances of the Conversion of St. Paul, and shew the importance which the Apostle appears to have attributed to them.
6. Miracles mentioned in the Acts. In what respect do they differ from those of our Lord?
7. "And last of all he was seen of me also, as of one born out of due time," 1 Cor. xv. Explain this. To what events does it allude?
8. Enumerate the companions of St. Paul, at different periods of his ministry.
9. A brief history of St. Stephen.
10. Situations of Cæsarea, Damascus, Berœa, Lystra, Rhegium, Attalia, Clauda.
11. Describe from the Catechism "your duty towards your neighbour," and state to which of the Commandments its articles severally refer.
12. "Because they promise *them both* by their sureties." What are these two promises, and in what terms are they made?
