3. Give genitive singular and meaning of : *ratio*, *carmen*, *ignis*, *fides*, *opus*.

4. Give the ablative singular of : *prosper*, *celeber*, *sacer*, *hostilis*, *dives*, *audax*, *vetus*, *amans*, *par*, *concor*.

5. Give the comparative of : *strenuus*, *tenuis*, *frugi*, *male*, *nuper*.

Give the Latin for : 2000 men, 13, 10, 21.

6. Give the genitive of *se*, the vocative singular masculine of *meus*, the nominative plural, all genders, of *idem*, the accusative singular, all genders, of *alius*, the dative singular, all genders of *uter*.
